

DIRECTIONS TO OAKGROVE PLANTATION:

FROM COLUMBIA OR ORANGEBURG, SC

Travel 321 south (Columbia) or 301 south (Orangeburg); 321 and 301 will merge just north of Ulmer. Travel 321 south; go through Sycamore and Fairfax. Continue south on 321 until you cross the Coosawhatchie River (green sign) south of Fairfax. After crossing the river, turn right at the top of the hill on 21 (Barton Rd.) and go across the R/R tracks. Turn immediately to your left down a dirt road (Plantation Rd.) and go approx. 1.5 miles. There will be a farm on your right and a “wrought iron” gate between a black fence on your left; this is the entrance to the OakGrove lodge. If you come to a church on your left, you have gone too far and must turn around. Estimated travel time is 2.0 hours (Columbia) and 1.25 hours (Orangeburg).

FROM ATLANTA OR AUGUSTA, GA

Traveling east on I-20, turn right on the Bobby Jones Expressway; the bypass going around Augusta. At the end of the Bypass, turn right onto 28. This will take you into Beech Island. Turn right onto 125 south. Travel 125 south through Jackson, and the Savannah River Site. Continue on through Martin; turn right on Highway 3. After crossing 301, continue on 3 for approx. 9.0 miles. Turn left at intersection onto 41 (Cohen’s Bluff Rd.; there will be a green sign to the right for Cohen’s Bluff boat landing). Travel 41 for 3.7 miles until you reach 49. Turn left on 49 (Groton Rd.), cross 19 after 2.0 miles, and go 1.1 miles until you reach a dirt road. At the first fork, stay right and after crossing a small creek the road will split, turn left (Groton Rd.). Continue on this dirt road until you come to a church; go straight up the clay hill (Plantation Rd.) and pass the church on your right. There will be a farm on your left and a “wrought iron” gate between a black fence on your right; this is the entrance to the OakGrove lodge. Estimated travel time is 1.5 hours.

FROM SAVANNAH, GA

Travel I-95 north to Hardeeville, SC. Travel 321 north to Gifford. After passing through Gifford, turn left on the second paved road 21 (Barton Rd.). Go across the R/R tracks, then turn immediately to your left down a dirt road (Plantation Rd.) and go approx. 1.5 miles. There will be a farm on your right and a “wrought iron” gate between a black fence on your left; this is the entrance to the OakGrove lodge. If you come to a church on your left, you have gone too far and must turn around. Estimated travel time is 1.0 hours.

FROM CHARLESTON, SC

Travel hwy. 17 to Jacksonboro, and veer right onto hwy. 64 to Walterboro. Turn left onto hwy. 63 and go across I-95 at exit 53. Stay on hwy. 63 all the way to Hampton. Turn right onto hwy. 278 and travel 6.5 miles to Brunson. After passing the Exxon on left, turn left on hwy. 12 (Hannah St.). Travel 3.6 miles to hwy. 321 and go straight across the highway (Barton Rd.). After crossing the R/R tracks, turn immediately to your left down a dirt road (Plantation Rd.) and go approx. 1.5 miles. There will be a farm on your right and a “wrought iron” gate between a black fence on your left; this is the entrance to the OakGrove lodge. If you come to a church on your left, you have gone too far and must turn around. Estimated travel time is 1.60 hours.
